Tasting Note

This wine shows true varietal expression of this classic Italian grape. Light and lively, it is instantly redolent of freshly picked apples and pears, with a delicate aroma of jasmine. Its clean, lifted flavours are alluring but not over-powering. It is gently perfumed with a fresh acidity and lingering floral notes.

The Vineyard

Our white wines are all made from fruit sourced from the cooler climate of the beautiful Adelaide Hills. Fruit for this Pinot Grigio was sourced from a single block nestled between Mount Torrens, Gumeracha and Birdwood, an undulating piece of land with a predominantly northern aspect. It has been the heart of the Aramis Pinot Grigio for several years and has a proven track record of producing fruit with perfume, balance and beautiful drinkability.

Winemaking Notes

Machine harvested in the cool of the night, crushed, pressed and settled. The juice was racked off solids, fermented cool, stabilised and bottled young to retain freshness. Our sole aim is to highlight the delicate, yet distinctive fruit characters of cool-climate Pinot Grigio, and for this reason, we do not pursue extended lees contact or barrel work.

Vintage Overview

Vintage 2021 was dry, with mild to warm days and cool nights allowing all the fruit to ripen beautifully without any pressures from disease or the weather. It could not have been better! One out of the box.
